White

332. 2018 Chablis Domaine Chevallier

Bright yellow in colour with perfumed white flowers and stone fruit on the nose. The palate is medium to full-bodied, with lively citrus acidity. The finish is minerally and long with the fresh acidity nicely balancing the full fruit.

333. 2020 Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc, Greywacke, New Zealand

Classic ripe Marlborough Sauvignon - with melon and gooseberry flavours and a touch of passionfruit, wound into a generous, mouth-filling palate that finishes dry and crisp.

334. 2019 Sancerre Domaine des Brosses, Loire, France

Bright and pale golden. A fresh, citrus palate with herbaceous notes of hay and nettle. Richly textured but with crisp acidity and textbook minerality. The finish is elegant with the typical purity and refreshment of excellent Sancerre.

Rosé

335. 2019 'Estérelle' Côtes-de-Provence, Château du Rouët, France

Pale salmon in colour with aromas of strawberry and rasperry, coupled with notes of wild thyme and rosemary. The palate is dry with refreshing acidity and the finish is long and scented.

Red

336. 2018 Merlot, Fog Mountain, California, USA

A rich and alluring Merlot. On the nose, it opens with aromas of baked plums and delicate violet notes. The palate offers flavours of cherries and hints of earthiness, with well-structured tannins and a long, satisfying finish.

337. 2016 Châteauneuf-du-Pape, Château de Vaudieu, Southern Rhône, France

Deep ruby red in colour, with a black cherry core. This wine has lively berry fruits on the nose, with a touch of liquorice and a hint of black pepper. On the palate, it's full-bodied and the ripe tannins are evident on the finish.

338. 2017 Amarone della Valpolicella Corte Giara, Italy

Characteristic hints of black cherry and freshly-ground black pepper are followed by subtle herb nuances on the nose. Dry and well-balanced, the characteristic acidity combines well with the softness of the fruit to produce a supple and powerful wine.

House White

- 01 **Pinot Grigio Ca' di Alte, Italy**
Medium-bodied, with good balance. Fresh and clean on the palate with a soft rounded finish.
- 02 **Sauvignon, Villa Montes, Chile**
Bright and lifted on the nose with lovely purity of fruit and racy acidity.
- 03 **Chardonnay, Peter Lehmann, Australia**
Attractive light green and gold in colour. Appealing aromas of freshly-cut white peaches. It has a beautiful soft depth of fruit on the middle palate and finishes clean and dry.

House Rosé

- 04 **Grenache Rosé IGP Pays d'Oc, Monrouby, France**
Pale salmon in colour, this refreshing Provençal-style rosé is brimming with fragrant red berry fruit with a hint of dried herbs. The palate is fresh with crisp acidity and a smooth finish.

House Red

- 05 **Merlot Ca' di Alte, Italy**
Velvety, round and full-bodied. The Merlot is riper and jucier than other Merlots from the Veneto.
- 06 **Cabernet Sauvignon, Villa Montes, Chile**
Deep, ruby red in colour, medium-bodied, with soft tannins, crisp acidity and a lingering finish.
- 07 **Shiraz, Wildcard, Peter Lehmann, Australia**
Cherry red in the glass, with hints of dark plum and chocolate on the nose. A fruit-driven palate with a soft tannin finish.

Crisp Whites

308. 2018 **'S' Soave Alpha Zeta, Italy** £21.45
Clean, bright aromas of almond blossom. With fresh acidity, the palate is ripe and concentrated, full of apple and pear flavours.
309. 2019 **Picpoul de Pinet Coteaux du Languedoc Baron de Badassiere, France** £25.95
Crisp apple aromas on the nose with good weight. Perfect with seafood.
310. 2020 **Sauvignon Blanc, Snapper Rock, New Zealand** £32.45
Light-bodied, dry and crisp. Classic NZ Sauvignon. Lovely aperitif or drink with lighter dishes.

311. 2019 **Macon-Villages, Domain Perraud, Burgundy** £32.95
Bright yellow in colour perfumed with white flowers and stone fruit. Medium to full bodied, with lively citrus acidity and flavours of melon, peach and a hint of pineapple.

Smooth Whites

312. 2018 **Viognier Baron De Badassiere, France** £25.95
Lovely nose of peach and white flowers. Similiar to the famous wines of Condrieu at a fraction of the price.
313. 2019 **Gavi di Gavi Terre Antiche, Italy** £29.95
Scented and delicate with hints of lime zest on the nose and fruit with a lovely zip and verve on the palate.

Full Whites

315. 2019 **Rioja Blanco, El Coto, Spain** £31.95
Pale yellow in colour, the wine is dry and fresh on the palate with aromas of peach, apple, citrus and tropical fruit.
316. 2019 **Kumeu River Village Chardonnay, New Zealand** £32.95
Truly outstanding. Influential wine writer Robert Whitley described this as "the world's finest Chardonnay for the money".

Rosé

317. 2019 **Pinot Grigio Rosé Ponte Pietra, Italy** £24.95
Attractive strawberry and sweet cherry aromas. Dry on the palate, with a vibrant character and fragrant finish.

Fruity Red

318. 2017 **Rioja Crianza Gran Dominio, Spain** £24.95
The palate is clean and well balanced, with a core of strawberry fruit combined with subtle vanilla flavours from American oak. The finish is juicy and long.
319. 2017 **Valpolicella Torre del Falasco, Italy** £29.95
Youthful, ruby-cherry in appearance with bright clean aromas of classic cherry and almond blossom.
320. 2018 **Kumeu River Village Pinot Noir, New Zealand** £33.95
The fine Pinot Noir is silky, aromatic and well balanced. Very Burgundian in character.

Smooth Reds

321. 2019 **Borgo Selene, Nero d'Avola-Nerello Mascalese, Italy** £29.45
This wine is ruby red in colour with notes of fresh berries on the nose. Round and smooth on the palate with soft tannins, the wine has lovely spiced cherry flavours that linger on the finish. £32.95
322. 2017 **Premieres Côtes-de-Bordeaux Rouge, Haut-Rian, France** £35.45
Lovely ruby red colour, elegant and rounded on the palate with good ripe fruit. Well-structured and medium-bodied.
323. 2018 **Chianti, Buontalenti, Italy**
Aged in large, untoasted casks to allow the quality of the fruit to shine, creating a bright cherry fruit aroma combined with hints of chocolate.

Full Reds

324. 2019 **Côtes-du-Rhône Rouge Les Terres du Roy, France** £29.95
Full of black and red berry fruit. It is supple, rich yet balanced with crisp acidity. It is delightful to drink now, on its own or paired with charcuterie, lamb or beef dishes. £29.95
325. 2018 **Malbec Colchagua Montes, Chile** £32.45
Rich acidity balances this excellent wine with medium body and rounded tannins that deliver a persistent finish.

326. 2018 **Jester Shiraz, McLaren Vale, Mitolo, Australia**
The nose is bright, lifted and aromatic with raspberry, blackberry and mint chocolate characters. The palate is concentrated with a luscious rolling texture and packed with fresh blackberry and plum.

Dessert Wine

327. 2013 **A Growers Touch Botrytis Semillon, Australia** £22.95
Interesting almond and apricot jam aromas with intense (also available by the glass @ £9.45 125ml) apricot flavours complexed with toffee, caramel, balanced sweetness and acidity with a hint of vanilla oak on the finish.

Sparkling Wine & Champagnes

328. **Prosecco Vino Spumante, Italy** £25.95
A soft bouquet, notes of pear and floral hints is followed by a bright and lifted palate.
330. **Brut Réserve Sophie Baron** £49.45
The Pinot Meunier-dominant blend gives richness and red berry fruit to this crisp and lively Champagne.
331. **Piper-Heidsieck Cuvée Brut, France** £62.95
On the nose, there are intense notes of almonds and fresh hazelnuts, with flavours of fresh pear and apple with a delicate hint of citrus.
